Job Purpose:

Ensure product compliance to vehicle regulations and conduct homologation activities in applicable sales markets.

Key Responsibilities and Tasks:

- Plan compliance activities to deliver cost-effective on-time market homologation including:
 - Managing, maintaining and delivering Vehicle Homologation Plans ensuring that market homologation delivery is harmonised with programme gateway timing, marketing roll-out plans and production load sequences.
 - Constructing, maintaining and delivering Compliance Validation Plan - detailed list of all compliance evidence required to a) underpin self-certification markets, b) certify/type approve and c) homologate in specified markets.
 - Compiling and presenting gateway compliance status to Programme and senior management in accordance with internal processes.
 - Input and maintenance of certification data and registration codes in Sales document systems.
- Provide technical interpretations and guidance to ensure product design and product performance achieves compliance, e.g.:
 - Access and navigate internal and external regulatory information sources, identifying applicable requirements and restrictions.
 - Give technical guidance on compliance solutions for component and system designers/engineers/managers.
 - Provide compliance guidance to support strategic decision making by senior management.
 - Obtaining clarification and interpretation of regulations from global regulatory bodies, Technical Services and consultants.
- Conduct technical compliance negotiations and presentations reflecting regulatory targets and subsequent development of cost effective plans to deliver robust compliance.
 - European type-approval worst-case determination (technical justification/explanation to allow test activity rationalisation) with case presentation/negotiation to UK and European Technical Services.
 - China worst-case determination with justifications communicated through intermediary consultant service to Chinese authorities.
 - In-house worst-case determination for self-certification markets.
 - Test facility and test equipment selection, costing and planning.
 - Test vehicle/equipment planning including transportation, management of test preparation/instrumentation, spares and support services.
- Compile and maintain compliance data and the creation of homologation documentation and illustrations.
 - Sourcing and collection of vehicle component and system data and images from suppliers and engineering teams.
 - Data validation.
 - Editing and compilation of compliance documents (using MS Office software and image manipulation software).
 - Organisation and manipulation of vehicle specification data in complex Excel data base.
- Lead and coordinate model market homologation activities.
 - Distribute homologation data to market representatives and file product data in various government systems as applicable.
 - Coordinate in-market test activities and support when required.
- Monitor product development changes to ensure compliance continuity.
 - Evaluation of product change proposals to determine possible compliance matters.
 - Engineering Release Sign-off to ensure that change introduction is coordinated with compliance activities.
 - Participation in AM problem resolution processes including Containment sign-off to ensure that the introduction of temporary problem resolution measures do not compromise vehicle compliance.
